
- In AY 2020-21, the University collects feedback from students on faculty members, theory and practical courses and Infrastructure, Procedural Discipline & Support Activities.




1. Faculty-wise Students Feedback on Courses (UG & PG)

This includes feedback on theory courses and practical courses across all semester both in UG and PG. Average student participation in UG was 52.89% and in PG was 76.15%.
















2. Faculty-wise Students Feedback on Faculty Members (UG & PG)


Average student participation in UG was 52.89% and in PG was 76.15%.





3. Students Feedback on Infrastructure, Procedural Discipline & Support Activities from Exit Batch Students (UG & PG)


For AY 2020-21 this feedback was taken from the exit batch students that include students of 3 year UG program and 2 years PG program. Average participation was of 52.18% students.
